

Medical Marijuana

State-by-State Overview

Document Summary:

- Thirty-eight (38) states, plus the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, and the Virgin Islands permit the medical use of marijuana.
- Twenty-four (24) states, plus the Dist rict of Columbia, the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, and the Virgin Islands have legalized the recreational use of marijuana for adults.
- Nine (9) states have enacted limited access marijuana product laws permitting only low (or zero)
 Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and high Cannabidiol (CBD) products to treat specific medical conditions.
- Three (3) states have prohibited all marijuana products, including those of low THC content and CBD products.
