The Board shall consist of the Commissioner of Public Health; the deans of the University of Kentucky College of Medicine, the University of Louisville College of Medicine, and the Pikeville College School of Osteopathic Medicine; twelve members appointed by the Governor, including one licensed osteopathic physician, and three licensed medical physicians including one African-American physician, one physician with a specialty in interventional pain management, and one physician who graduated from an international medical school; six members from a list of names provided by the Medical Association; and six citizens who are representatives of a recognized statewide consumer advocacy organization. Previously, the Board consisted of the Commissioner, the deans from the University of Kentucky and Pikeville, the vice-dean for clinical affairs at Louisville, one licensed osteopathic physician and seven licensed medical physicians, and three consumer members. The KMA or the Kentucky Osteopathic Association previously submitted the physician names. Requires the Board
