### **New FCVS Accepting State Medical Boards**

The Alaska State Medical Board is the newest board to accept the FCVS profile of verified physician credentials for licensure. The total number of boards accepting FCVS verified credentials for physicians is up to 63.

The Mississippi State Board of Medical Licensure, the Texas Medical Board, the Vermont Board of Medical Practice and the West Virginia Board of Medicine recently began accepting FCVS verified credentials for physician assistants seeking licensure. The total number of boards accepting FCVS verified credentials for physician assistants is now at 29.

### **New FCVS Requiring State Medical Boards**

The Wyoming Board of Medicine is the newest board to require international medical school graduates to utilize FCVS to verify physicians' credentials when applying for licensure. The total number of boards requiring FCVS verified credentials for physicians is now at 14.

The Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine is the newest board to require physician assistants seeking licensure to utilize FCVS. The total number of boards requiring FCVS verified credentials for physician assistants is now at two.

### **Coming Soon – Secure Web-based PGT Verifications**

In spring 2008, postgraduate training program directors will have access to a secure website that allows them to provide verifications of their trainees. The website is the result of a focus group consisting of individuals from the Association of Family Medicine Administration, The Cleveland Clinic, The University of Kentucky and the Council of Review Committee Residents of the ACGME, which have been working with FCVS to ensure the website is easy to navigate and use.
